



Thank you for sending your Son Jesus down to save us.






## RESURRECTION SCAVENGER HUNT Something Black - Represents sin. Bread - Jesus broke this and shared with His disciples. Palm Leaf - Laid in the Street when Jesus entered Jerusalem. Silver Coins - Judas was willing to betray Jesus for 30 coins. Grape Leaf or Thorn - Jesus' crown was made of grapevine thorns. Perfume - Mary Poured on Jesus' feet. 2 Sticks - Jesus' Cross Something Red - Jesus' Blood Nails - To secure Jesus to the cross. Rock - Tomb Spice Bag - Spices were used to prepare Jesus for burial. Something Empty - Jesus has risen! White/Cream Cloth - All that remained in the tomb. Something New - The old is gone and new has come!
