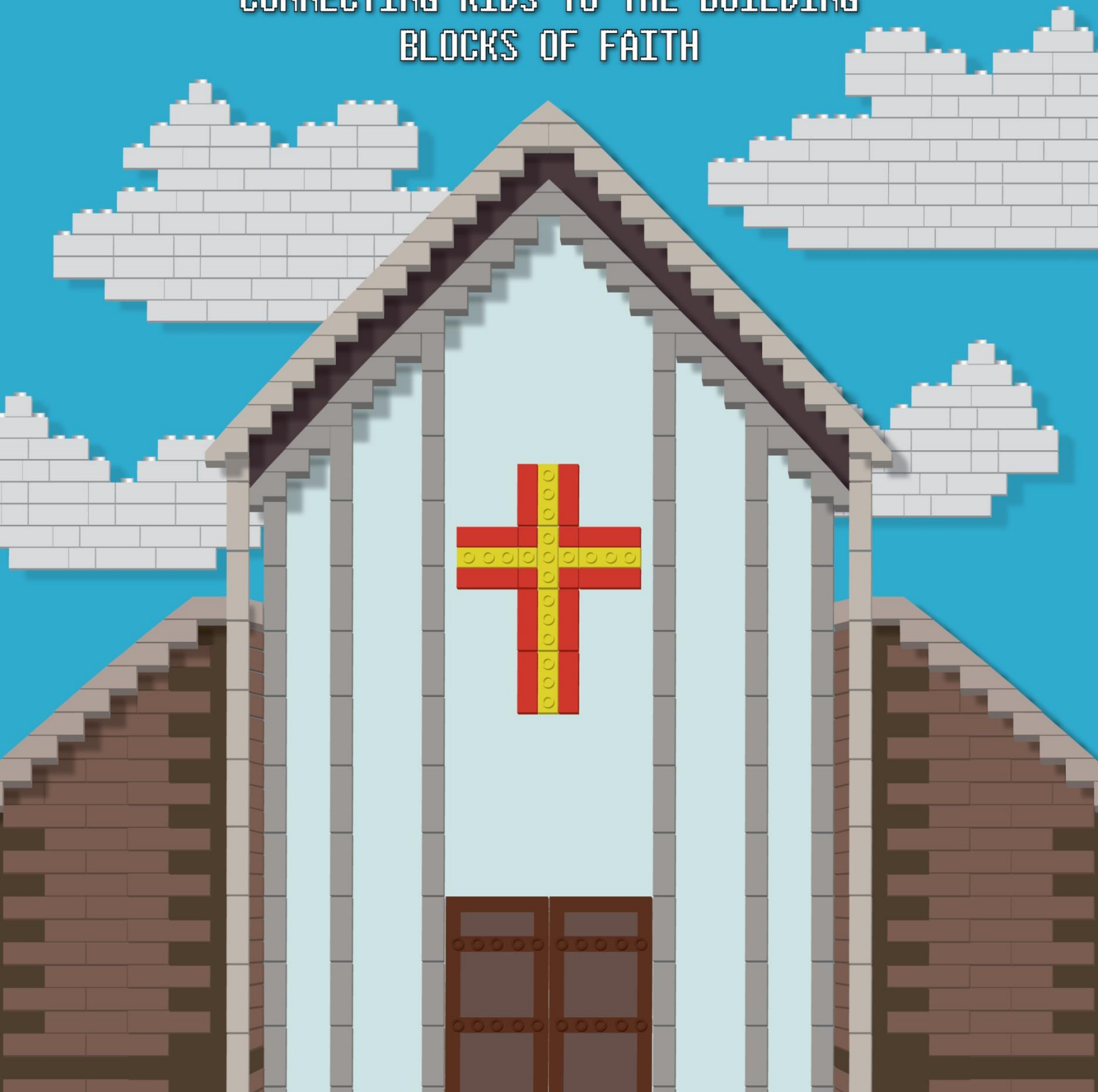

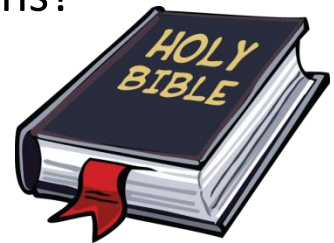
Family Activity Strengths

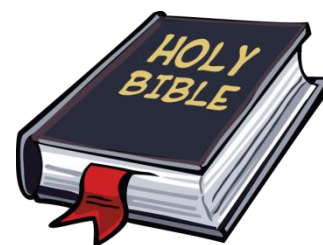
Donations

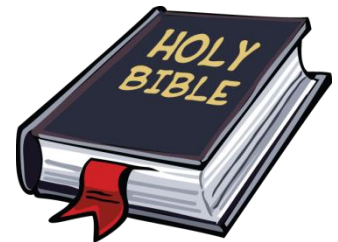
Worship

Help me to constantly worship you in every situation I am in.

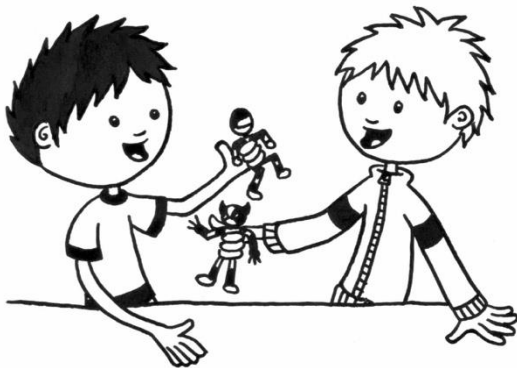
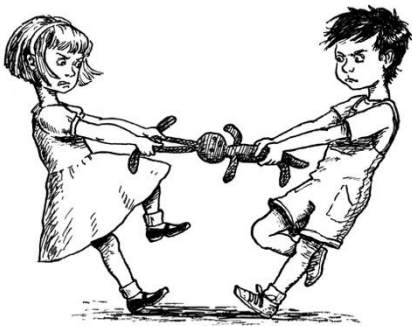

Family Activity

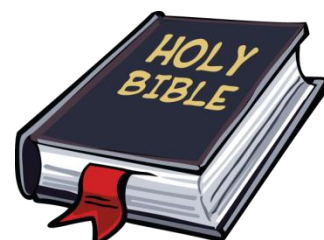
Pancake Party

Thank you for sharing your Son Jesus with us.

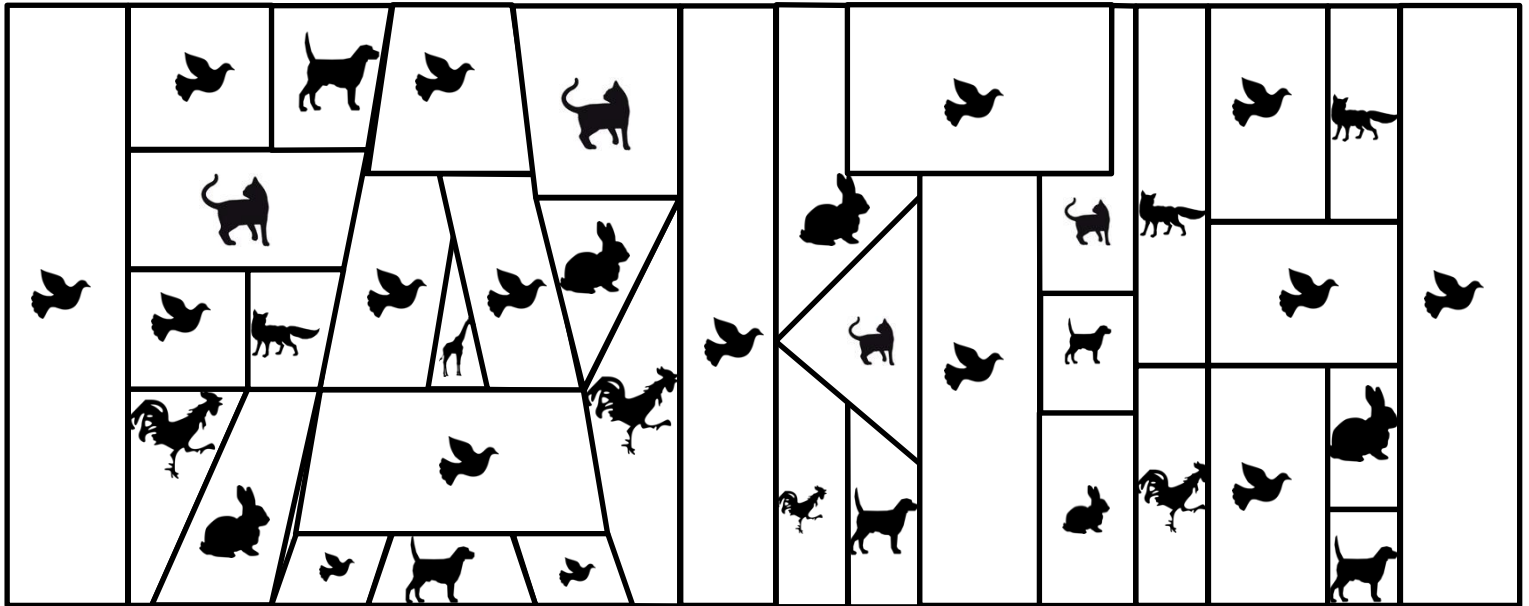
Help me to share the Good News with all my friends.

This man obeyed God and prepared an ark to prepare for a giant flood. Who was he? (Hebrews 11:7)

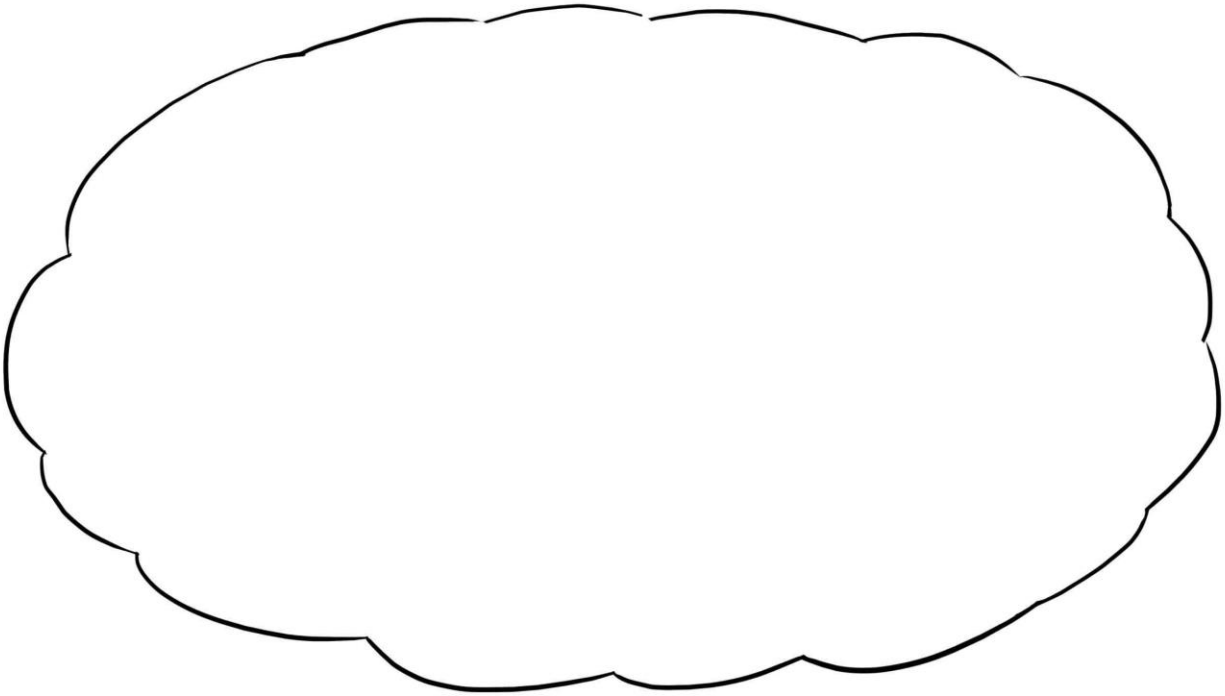
This man obeyed God and left everything to go to the land God had promised him. Who was he? (Hebrews 11:8-10)

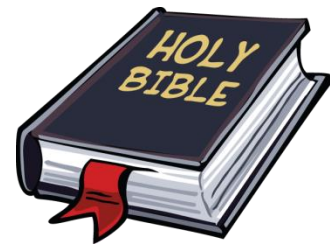

Help us always keep our eyes on you.

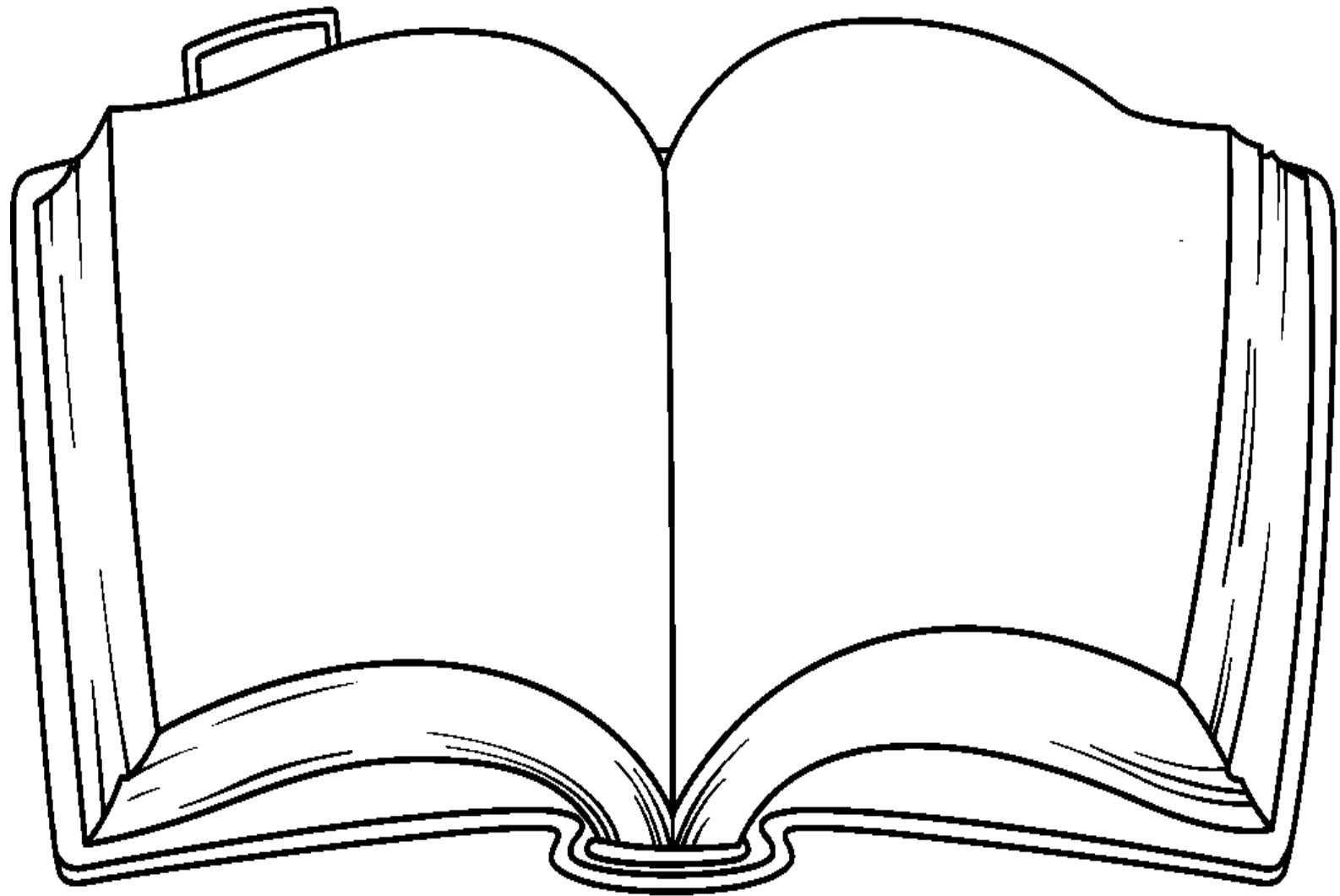

Thank you for the wisdom that it gives me.

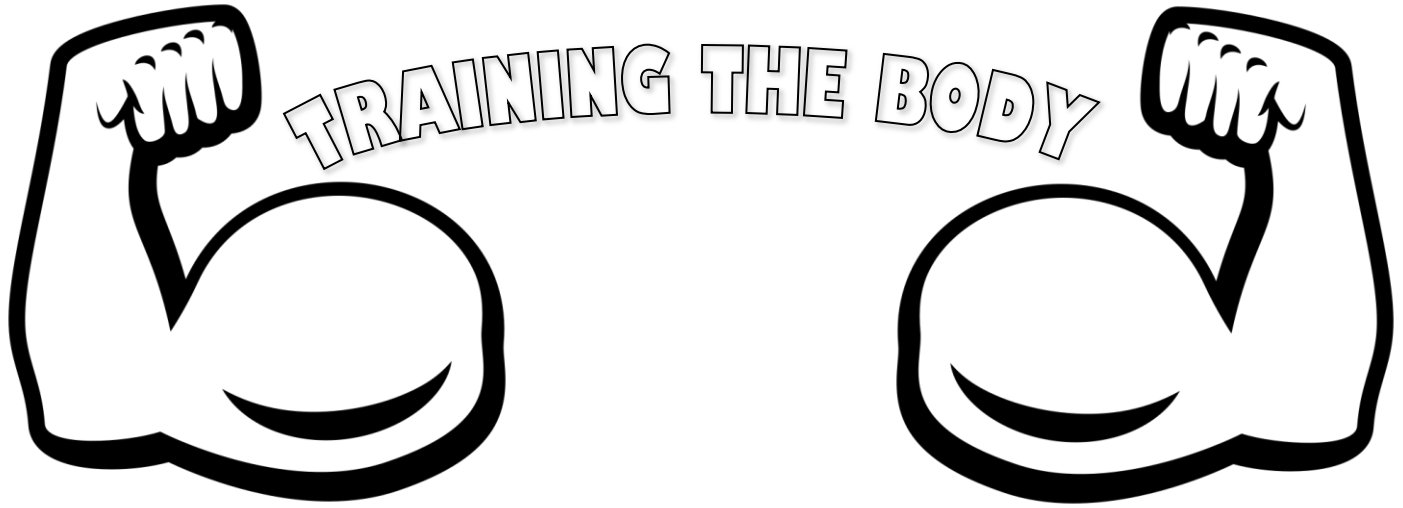

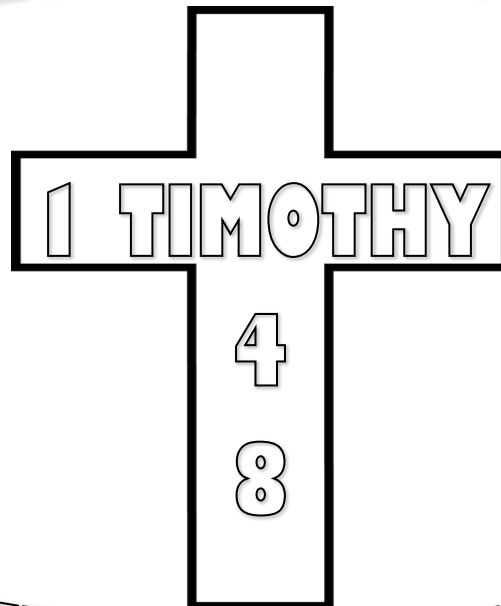

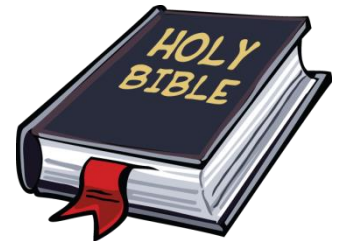
Memory Verses
