Can I contact my child at camp?

Our goal at camp is to help kids experience Christ in a distraction free environment. Therefore, we don't allow phones at camp in order to help create that environment. We will give every parent at registration a staff phone number in case there is an emergency and you need to contact your child.

Will I receive updates about camp?
