Guided Story Time

Recap what we learned today with your kids.

- How long was Jesus buried in the tomb? *3 days*
- How long did Jesus appear to his disciples? *40 days*
- Who was Jesus sending to be their helper? *The Holy Spirit*
- What did Jesus tell his disciples to do? *To go out and tell everyone about Jesus*
- What did Jesus promise us? *That he would always be with us*

Big Idea Application – Be Prepared to Share Jesus

These questions are designed to help kids apply the lesson to their own lives. Ask these questions to help start the conversation!

- How can you share the love of Jesus today in your own home?
- What can you do as a family to share Jesus with others?

Game/Activity

Sharing Jesus with others can be hard and scary sometimes. But if we practice sharing things about us, then sharing the most important thing becomes easier. Read through these questions together as a family and take turns sharing your answer.

1. If you could go into any TV show – what show would you want to visit?
2. If you could only eat one fruit forever – what fruit would it be?
3. What are three words you would use to describe yourself?
4. If you went to another planet – what would you bring with you?
5. If you were a teacher what rules would you make?
6. If you could make your whole house out of food – what food would you use?
7. If you could have one super power what would it be?
8. If you could be an animal what would you be?
9. If you could be anyone when you grew up – who would you want to be?
10. Which is better – being invisible or being able to fly?
11. If we could only have one holiday – which one would you pick?
12. If your pets could talk – what would they say?
13. If you could read someone's mind – whose mind would you want to read?
14. If you were invisible – where would you want to go?
15. If you could make the laws – what is one law you would create?
16. If you could make up any holiday – what would it be called?
17. If you could only have Christmas or your Birthday each year which one would you pick?
18. Which is better to be – funny or honest?
19. What's your funniest face?
20. If you could make three family rules – what would they be?

21. If you had to rename yourself –what name would you give yourself?

Sharing silly and embarrassing things can be hard at first, but once you get going it gets a lot easier. It's the same when we share Jesus with others. The more we share him with others, the easier it gets!

Memory Verse

Read the memory verse (found at the top of the paper) together. Scripture memorization is one of the greatest tools that God gives us. When we memorize God's word, we can apply it to our life every single day.
