Big Idea: Jesus is the Best Gift

Memory Verse: “For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.”

John 3:16 (NLT)

Guided Story Time- Jesus’ Sacrifice (Luke 23:26-43)

Recap what we learned today with your kids.

- Who is God’s son? *Jesus*
- What were the Jewish leaders planning to do? *Arrest Jesus*
- Who agreed to betray Jesus? *Judas, one of his disciples*
- What was Jesus doing when he was arrested? *Praying*
- What did they put on Jesus’ head? *A crown of thorns*
- What did Jesus have to carry up the mountain? *A cross*
- Why did Jesus die on the cross? *To pay for our sins so we could be forgiven*
- Did Jesus stay dead? *No, he rose from the dead 3 days later*

Big Idea Application –Jesus is the Best Gift

These questions are designed to help kids apply the lesson to their own lives. Ask these questions to help start the conversation!

- Why is Jesus our best gift ever?
- How can we share our best gift with others?

Game/Activity

Jesus is the best gift we could ever get! It would be selfish of us to keep this amazing gift to ourselves.
