







Trace the lines to finish the picture of Jesus.

Can you see it?

There are some things we can see and some things we can't see. Let's sort those things together. Remember that even though we can't see Jesus, he is real! Jesus says that we are happy if we believe even though we don't see him.



Cut out the pictures and put them in the bucket where they belong.



Let's go on a scavenger hunt to find things that remind us of the Easter story! That way we can remember Jesus and what He did on Easter every day.

A rock - reminds us of Jesus' tomb
Two sticks - remind us of Jesus' cross
Something new - reminds us that Jesus gives us a new life NEW
Draw a cloud you see - reminds us that Jesus lives in Heaven
Something white - reminds us that Jesus forgave us
A fallen leaf - reminds us of the palm branches used during Jesus' triumphal entry
Draw an animal - reminds us of the donkey Jesus rode to Jerusalem
Something empty - reminds us of Jesus' empty tomb
Something black - reminds us that Jesus died for our sins

Jesus Is Alive!

Bible Truth: The tomb was empty, Jesus is Alive!

Bible Story: Jesus was crucified, but after three days He rose again!

Memory Verse: "For God so loved the world, that He gave His one and only son, so

that whoever believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life." John 3:16

This craft helps remind kids what an amazing sacrifice Jesus made for us on the cross!

Supplies:

- Construction paper or cardstock
- Markers, crayons, washable paint, or watercolors
- Tape


Instructions:

- 1. Have your kiddo tape a cross on their paper in whatever size they like!
- 2. Have them write "Jesus is Alive" with a crayon!
- **3.** Paint or color with the markers over the entire paper; going over the top of the taped cross.
- 4. Once it is dry, remove the tape to reveal the cross beneath it!










